This one day course has been granted accreditation by the US-EPA Lead to engage in lead-based paint training for the **Renovation, Repair and Painting Program** pursuant to 40 CFR Part 745, Subpart L (73 FR 21691, April 22, 2008). The accreditation allows this initial course to be offered in **English** in the **State of Florida**.

The value of this training includes meeting EPA and HUD requirements for lead-safety work practices training under the RRP rule; renovators obtain EPA certification after successful completion of the course; and completing this training demonstrates your company's competence to prospective clients and can be a marketing advantage that distinguishes your company from the competition.

This new EPA rule is aimed at protecting children from lead-based paint hazards in places they frequent. The rule requires that contractors and maintenance professionals working in housing, child-care facilities (defined as residential, public, or commercial buildings where children under age six are present on a regular basis), and schools built prior to 1978 be certified; that their employees be trained; and that they follow protective work practice standards. www.epa.gov/lead

The Rule is Effective April 22, 2010

- Renovation firms must be certified.
- Renovators must be trained and certified.
- Renovators must educate owners/occupants
- Non-certified workers must work under and be trained on-the-job by a Certified Renovator
- Work practices must be followed for work covered by the rule.
